Judging commences at 11.15am. No entry to the venue while judging is in progress.

All exhibits in the Sections A1, A2 and C must be grown by the exhibitor.

Cups will be awarded for most points in each Section, for the person gaining most points in the Show, for the best arrangement in the Decorative Section, the Premier Bloom in the Daffodil Section, and the runner up in the Daffodil Section.

Prizes will be presented at 1.30pm on Saturday 14th September

Flowers and vegetables left will be used as gifts for people in the community.

POINT SYSTEM

In all cases where points are added to assess a winner for a trophy or prize, points will be awarded as follows - 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1 point. If an exhibitor has more than one entry in a class, only the highest placing can gain points for the trophy.
